I. John¹ MCCUBBIN was born; John's name taken from son William's death cert. He married Agnes HODGEON. He was a Linen Weaver as recorded from childrens' records.

A. William² MCCUBBIN was a Cotton Weaver as recorded on childrens' records. He was born circa 1798; birth calculated from death cert. He married Mary HENRY 'HENDRY' on 4 May 1823 in Maybole, Ayr, Scotland; IGI M116054. He died on 14 Oct 1882 in Coral Glen, Maybole, Ayr, Scotland; age 84 at death. GRO death extract transcribed by HCurtis.

1. James³ MCCUBBIN was a Weaver as listed on daughter Agnes' death reg. He was born circa 1825; birth calculated from death cert. He married Marion GOUDIE on 14 Nov 1845 in Maybole, Ayr, Scotland; Source: GRO Extract of Birth of daughter Mary McCubbin. He was a Handloom Cotton Weaver at the time of birth of daughter Mary in 1855. He was a Handloom Weaver at the time of son John's marriage in 1870. He lived in 1875 in 35 Bishop St, Anderston; at the time of grandaughter Marion's death. He was a Church Officer as noted on son William's marriage reg in 1878. He was a Spirit Salesman as recorded on daughter Agnes' marriage reg in 1882. He died on 21 Nov 1893 in 15 Sydney Street, Glasgow, Dist of Dennistoun, Lanark, Scotland; age 68 at death Hepatic Cancer. A Night Watchman. Son John informant. GRO death 644/03 2001.

He married Elizabeth MCGREGOR on 18 Mar 1870 in 20 India Street, Blythswood, Glasgow, Scotland; Bride & Groom residing at 35 Bishop Street, Anderston, Glasgow. Witnesses James McCubbin & Agnes Shanks. Married according to the forms of the Free Church of Scotland. GRO marriages SBraid transcriber. IGI M119271.

He married Helen MCPHAIL on 28 Oct 1870 in 20 India Street, Blythswood, Glasgow, Scotland; Groom residing at 35 Bishop St., Anderston, Glasgow. Bride residing at 4 Shaftsbury, Glasgow. Witnesses James McGaughlan & Jessie McCubbin. GRO marriages S Braid transcribed. IGI M119271. He was a Baker according to daughter's death reg in 1874 in Glasgow.

(1) James⁵ MCCUBBIN was born on 30 Aug 1871 in Anderston, Glasgow, Lanark, Scotland; gave age on marriage cert as 18. IGI C119311. He was an Iron Borer at time of marriage in 1890. He married Kate CROWE on 28 Jul 1890 in 92 Gloucester Street, Glasgow, Scotland; Declaration in presence of two witnesses. David McPhail & Flora McPhail. Groom & Bride living at 22 Oakland St, Glasgow. GRO marriages SBraid.

(2) Donald⁵ MCCUBBIN was born on 8 May 1873 in Anderston, Glasgow, Lanark, Scotland; IGI C119311. He died on 16 Nov 1873 in 27 West Greenhill Place, Glasgow; Marasmus 5 months old. Mother, informant. GRO death 644/8 1119 transcribed by HCurtis.

He lived in 1878 in 128 Stobcross St, Glasgow; and Elizabeth Lee, fiance, living at 192 Stobcross St. He married Elizabeth LEE on 27 Dec 1878 in 56 Carrick Street, Glasgow, Scotland; Groom 25, Bride 19, Maried according to the Forms of the Free Church of Scotland. Witnesses Allister Lee & Martha Lee. GRO marriages SBraid transcribed. He died on 19 Nov 1891 in Gourock Parochial Asylum/Usual res. 34 East Hamilton St. Greenock, Gourock, Renfrew; 37 at death. Influenza. A Foreman Painter.GRO death 567/02 0164 from SP internet.

(1) John⁵ MCCUBBIN was born in 1886; birth calculated from marriage reg. He was a Sugar Boiler at time of marriage in 1904. He married Agnes Porterfield Miller MCLAUGHLIN on 19 Sep 1904 in 19 Ardgowan (sp?) Square, Greenock, Renfrew, Scotland; According to the forms of the Evangelical Union Church. Groom 18 yrs, living at 22 Nelson St West, Greenock. Father deceased. Mother living married to McLellan. Bride, Agnes McLaughlin, a Dressmaker, living at 14 Murdieston St, Greenock. Her parents John McLoughlin, a Sugar Boiler & Margaret Miller. Witnesses were Alex McCubbin & Bella Miller. Certificate purchased from GRO Scotland's People on-line. LMc.

(c) Alexander⁶ MCCUBBIN married May (--?--). He was born on 17 Dec 1914 in Greenock; info provided by Alex in an email 14/02/2001. He was the writer of the following: My father was John McCubbin and he married Agnes Porterfield Miller McLaughlin in Greenock on the 19th day of September 1904. He was 18 and his bride 17. Shortly after they boarded ship for HongKong where my father was to be employed in the Taikoo Sugar Refinery. In those days you had a contract for 5 years then were granted a years vacation. During those 5 years my sister and brother were born. At the end of the contract the family sailed for Greenock, Scotland for their vacation. My father returned to HK alone because of the war situation, and my mother was with child and advised not to travel. I was born Alexander on Dec. 17th 1914 and have little memory of my early life. We stayed with my great grandma, grandma, and mother. Mother was a seamstress and Grandma a Midwife. It was said that she delivered half the babies in Greenock, no doubt an exaggeration. My father did not see me until I was about five years old, when the family reunited in HK after the war.

It seemed no time until my father was due for a holiday and in 1923 we sailed for San Fransisco where a family reunion was in the offing. My Grandmother, her four sons, one daughter, 20 grandsons and two grandaughters all attended. I have no info on my grandfather who must have died. The son of one of my uncles had been born in Malta and as the Maltese quota of immigrants was full he was detained on Ellis Island. The family wouldn't let him go alone so all the family were detained on Ellis Island. However the situation was soon rectified and all went well. I still have the family picture taken at that time. We returned to HK, everyone else remained in San Francisco and multiplied.

In 1928 my father retired from the Taikoo Sugar Refinery and we boarded ship this time to return to the land of our roots. We finished our schooling and started to work for a living. Bessie became a clerk typist, John, followed in Dad's footsteps and went to India in the Sugar trade and I went into an Accountants office and later the Cinema business.

In 1938 I was married and my American Grandma (Dad's mum) and her daughters came home for a holiday and so were guests at our wedding. A year later another war. This time I was involved and volunteered for service eventually ending up in the Scottish Commandos. Sent out to the Middle East I was in Alexandria in Egypt when my first born, a daughter was born. Alexandra Anne Sept. 10 1941. After various actions in the middle east, Cypress, Syria and the Western Desert I was made a POW and spent the next 3 years behind wire. When the war ended I was expatriated and saw my daughter for the first time and returned to my job in the cinema, later becoming manager of LaScala Cinema. A year later May gave birth to a son Campbell.

In 1954 we decided to change our life style and immigrated to Canada and chose Calgary in Alberta. I worked for an Oil Company until I retired. Campbell had married Marilyn Murphy and Anne had married Edward Sidorchuk. Campbell has a son Alexander Campbell who recently had a daughter Aislyn. Anne also had a daughter Katherine Anne and two sons James Edward and Kenneth John. Katherine Anne is married to Keiran Kelly and lives in Toronto. James Edward has two sons Alexandre and Nicolas. Kenny also increased the family with a boy named Samuel.

In 1955 decided it was time to visit the McCubbins in San Francisco. Met all my cousins, uncles and their

families. On May 23, 1966 a Family Tree was prepared but hasn't been brought up to date, but is available.

As the oldest living twig on my father's branch the only male McCubbins left at this date are Alexander, son Campbell, grandson Alex and my late brother's [John] son Colin who now lives in Whistler B.C in 2001.

She married Samuel KERR on 4 Jun 1880 in 128 Strobcross Street, Glasgow, Scotland; GRO marriages S.Braid transcribed.

g) Henry⁴ MCCUBBIN was born on 18 Jul 1857 in Maybole, Ayr, Scotland; IGI C116051. He died on 16 Nov 1858 in Maybole, aYR, at age 1; aged 16 months. Fever 14 days. GRO deaths HCurtis transcribed.

h) Agnes⁴ MCCUBBIN was born on 6 Apr 1859 in Maybole, Ayr, Scotland; IGI C116051. She was a Boot & Shoe Sales(woman) at time of marriage in 1882. She married Robert IRONSIDE on 28 Nov 1882 in 128 Stobcross Street, Glasgow, Scotland; Bride & Groom both living at 128 Stobcross Street, Glasgow. Witnesses Andrew Jamieson & Jane McCubbin. Married according to the Forms of the Free Church of Scotland. GRO Marriages S Braid transcribed. As of 28 Nov 1882, her married name was IRONSIDE. She died on 4 Mar 1885 in Kirk Wynd, Falkirk, at age 25; Puerperal Peritonitis. Robert Ironside informant. GRO479/1 transcribed by HCurtis.

i) Jane⁴ MCCUBBIN was born on 22 Apr 1861 in Maybole, Ayr, Scotland; IGI C116051. She married James ROSS on 25 Jun 1897 in The Manse, South Leith, Scotland; GRO marriage transcribed by SBraid. Jane a farm servant, age 37.

j) Marion⁴ MCCUBBIN was born on 19 May 1863 in Anderston, Glasgow, Lanark, Scotland; IGI C119311. She married William Wilson CALDER on 11 Apr 1890 in Chalmers St Hall, Glasgow, Ayr, Scotland; GRO marriages S Braid transcribed.
